As one of the four great inventions of China, paper not only demonstrates its own value in the preservation and circulation of literary and artistic works, but also provides means of livelihood for a large number of common people.

Numerous generations and communities have lived, prospered and passed down experiences from generation to generation through the production, circulation and use of paper.
